**SUBJECT:** Certification Of The Election Results Of The Official Canvass For The General Municipal Election Of November 7, 2017

**RECOMMENDATION:** That Council:

- A. Adopt, by reading of title only, A Resolution of the Council of the City of Santa Barbara Reciting the Fact of the Vote-By-Mail General Municipal Election Held on November 7, 2017, and Declaring the Results and Setting Forth Such Other Matters as Required by the State Elections Code; and
- B. Receive a final presentation on the November 7, 2017 Election.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Vote-By-Mail General Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, for the purpose of electing the Mayor and three City Councilmembers who will represent City Council Districts 4, 5, and 6, and voting on a ballot measure. The Certification of Election Results of the Official Canvass from the City Clerk's Office is an exhibit to the Resolution.

As provided in the City Charter, the terms of office for Mayor-Elect Cathy Murillo and Councilmembers-Elect Kristen Sneddon, Eric Friedman, and Gregg Hart will begin on January 9, 2018, the first scheduled meeting in January following the certification of election results. A swearing-in ceremony will be held at the City Council meeting on that date.
